

WRCC Board Meeting – May 15, 2006

- 1) Minutes of April 17, 2006 meeting were accepted and will be posted on the WRCC website.
- 2) Joe Bolan as stepped down as club President. Vice President, Andy Hirsch will assume the duties of President until the next election cycle. The Board accepted nomination of Greg Small as Vice President. Kelly Grieger will replace Greg as a member of the Board. Corrine volunteered to assume the role of Advocacy Chair.
- 3) Rob reported that the balance in our bank account is \$9,368 as of April 30, 2006. We've taken in \$941 in 2006 dues. Century expenses thus far are \$1150. No Century deposits have been received thus far.
- 4) 2006 Century:
 - a. Century packets (along with information from the Lafayette Visitor's Bureau) were sent out to individuals, bike clubs and bike shops in late April.
 - b. The Family Ride SAG will be located at the New Miracle Bethel Church located at 7525 S 775 E. (close to Wainwright School), pending proof of insurance. Rob will try to wrap up the Century Ride insurance in the very near future.
 - c. A list of Century volunteers will be posted on the club website so members can be informed as to where more volunteers and sub-chairs are needed.
- 5) Old Business:
 - a. Greg spoke with the people who run the Prophet's Town Museum about bike racks. They are very much in need of some. Greg will follow up with them regarding an estimate of their need. He will contact the Visitor's Bureau and Dan at Hodson's Bay to get their buy-in. The club might spend as much as \$500 on this project.
 - b. Chloe will look into an overnight trip to the Shades in July in an effort to inject more fun into our lives!
- 6) New Business:
 - a. There was general recognition of the need for a Ride Czar – someone who actively recruits ride leaders.
 - b. Corrine suggested that the club purchase some cycling DVDs and donate them to the library (perhaps splitting the collection between the County Library and the West Lafayette Library). Better yet, she will try to convince the Libraries to buy them!
 - c. A proposal was made to have a mechanism for proposing rides on a timetable shorter than the current monthly schedule. The merits of this proposal were discussed with consideration given to the positives (additional rides with ride leaders) and the negatives (possible decrease in

rides placed on the Ride Calendar, how to notify people who do not have internet access). A formal proposal will be drawn up.
